27TH THESES AWARDS 2019

1. SPE Italian Section, EAGE and Assomineraria announce the 27th "G. Sclocchi" Theses Award.

2. University graduates from Italian universities and Italian nationals graduated abroad, who have completed their studies in the period **1/11/2018 – 31/12/2019**, are entitled to submit their published thesis

3. The thesis must cover subjects related to Energy, including:

Geology, Geophysics and Formation Evaluation
 Exploration, Production and Transport of Hydrocarbons, including LNG
 Health, Safety, Environment, Carbon Management and Neutrality
 Renewable Sources, Energy transition and Circular Economy
 Green Refinery Feedstocks
 Energy Economics & Management

4. Candidates must comply with the following strict deadlines:

Contact Information and Abstract – December 31st, 2019
Complete electronic copy of the thesis – January 31th, 2020
Graduation Certificate – before the Award Ceremony in March 2020

5. Members of the Boards of Directors of the SPE Italian Section, the EAGE-SEG Italian Section, and Assomineraria will jointly appoint the Evaluation Committee, composed by experts in the above-mentioned areas. The Evaluation Committee decision is final and not subject to appeal.

6. The theses will be evaluated and awarded according to the following categories:

- A. Master of Science (Laurea Magistrale) and Doctor of Philosophy (Dottorato di Ricerca)
- B. 2nd Level Master and Bachelor of Science (Laurea di I livello)

7. A maximum of three prizes for category A, two prizes for category B, and six special mentions will be awarded. The prize for each thesis awarded under category A will be 2400€ (twenty-four hundred Euros) and a plaque. The prize for each thesis awarded under category B will be 1200€ (twelve hundred Euros) and a plaque. Optional awards for running-up theses will consist of a "special mention" plaque. Reference to award-winning theses will be published in the «SPE Bulletin» of the Italian Section, in the «EAGE First Break» journal, and on www.assomineraria.org.

8. The Award ceremony will take place in the **"Aula Magna" of Politecnico di Milano (Piazza Leonardo da Vinci)** and the winners of categories A and B will deliver a short presentation of their theses. Winners will be notified in due time of the date of the ceremony and of the presentation guidelines.
